

Process for Selection of TrialNet Chair

1. The opportunity to apply to be the TrialNet Network Chair will be publicized. The application will be distributed to all TrialNet investigators and will be posted on the TrialNet and other public websites. The application will include a listing of the responsibilities of the Network Chair and the expected time commitment. The application will request information about the applicant's experience with clinical trials, leadership positions in clinical trials and in other areas involving collaboration with industry, interaction with the type 1 diabetes community, involvement in TrialNet, available time to commit to the position, and submission of a Curriculum Vitae.
2. A committee will be established by NIDDK to review the applications. The committee will include selected TrialNet Clinical Center Directors as well as experts outside of TrialNet.
3. The Chair Review Committee will consider each candidate's strengths and weaknesses, identify the top three candidates, and forward this list to NIDDK. References may be requested for the top three candidates.
4. NIDDK will make the final Chair selection.

Miscellaneous

The Network Chair will serve a partial year as chair elect, followed by a five-year term. Evaluation by the NIDDK will occur annually.

Timeline for Selection of Network Chair 2020-2021

October 2020:	Distribute TrialNet Chair application, publicize opportunity
December 15, 2020:	Last date for receipt of applications
December 2020/January 2021	Select Review Committee
January 2021:	Review of candidates by Review Committee
January/February 2021:	NIDDK selects chair
